Luce

Official mascot of the Holy Year

Luce is the Italian word for light. The color of the raincoat is inspired by the Vatican flag and also symbolizes “a journey through life's storms” . She is holding a pilgrim's staff, which represents “an unending pilgrimage” , and is wearing dirty boots, which represent “a long and difficult journey” . Her eyes have a scallop shell-shaped highlight, which is a traditional symbol of Catholic pilgrimages. The shining eyes express “the symbol of hope in the heart” . Luce is also wearing a rosary around her neck.

〈What is a Holy Year〉

●A Holy Year is a year in which the Pope grants plenary indulgences to believers who meet certain conditions. There are two types of Holy Years: the Ordinary Holy Year, which is held regularly every 25 years, and the Special Holy Year, which is held for special intentions.

●The Pope opens the Holy Door of St. Peter's Basilica, and similar ceremonies are held at the Basilica of St. John Lateran, the Basilica of St. Mary Major, and the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls. At the end of the Holy Year, the doors are closed.

●During the Holy Year, plenary indulgences are granted to the faithful who visit Rome or other designated churches, receive the sacrament of penance, participate in Mass, and pray according to the Pope's intentions.



〈Explanation of the logo〉

●All of humanity, gathered from the four corners of the earth, holds the cross, a sign of faith and hope, in solidarity and friendship. The waves show that the journey of life is not always a smooth journey, but the “anchor of hope” has been lowered.

●The pilgrimage is a communal journey, with a dynamism that leads us towards the cross.

Bull of Indiction of The Ordinary Jubilee “Spes Non Confundit”

Spes Non Confundit. “Hope does not disappoint” (Rom 5:5). In the spirit of hope, the Apostle Paul addressed these words of encouragement to the Christian community of Rome. Hope is also the central message of the coming Jubilee that, in accordance with an ancient tradition, the Pope proclaims every twenty-five years. My thoughts turn to all those pilgrims of hope who will travel to Rome to experience the Holy Year and to all those others who, though unable to visit the City of the Apostles Peter and Paul, will celebrate it in their local Churches. For everyone, may the Jubilee be a moment of genuine, personal encounter with the Lord Jesus, the “door” (cf. Jn 10:7.9) of our salvation.

Let us even now be drawn to this hope! Through our witness, may hope spread to all those who anxiously seek it. May the way we live our lives say to them in so many words: “Hope in the Lord! Hold firm, take heart and hope in the Lord!” (Ps 27:14). May the power of hope fill our days, as we await with confidence the coming of the Lord Jesus Christ, to whom be praise and glory, now and forever.

Visiting a designated church on the pilgrimage and receiving plenary indulgence

● Indulgence is the forgiveness before God of a limited punishment for a sin that has already been forgiven. It can be obtained when one has the proper state of mind and fulfills certain conditions. Indulgence is divided into partial and plenary indulgence, depending on whether the release from the limited punishment is partial or total. (From the Catechism of the Catholic Church)

● Indulgence is seen as a gift of grace specific to each Holy Year. All the faithful, who are truly repentant and free from any affection for sin, who are moved by a spirit of charity and who, during the Holy Year, purified through the sacrament of penance and refreshed by Holy Communion, pray for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff, will be able to obtain from the treasury of the Church a plenary indulgence, with remission and forgiveness of all their sins, which can be applied in suffrage to the souls in Purgatory in the following ways.

(Decree of the Apostolic Penitentiary, 13 May 2024)

● Visiting the Cathedral or other church designated by the local Ordinary, and there, for a suitable period of time, engage in Eucharistic adoration and meditation, concluding with the Our Father, the Profession of Faith in any legitimate form, and invocations to Mary, the Mother of God.

Rules for plenary indulgence by the Apostolic Penitentiary

You can only receive plenary indulgence once a day. To be eligible for this, you must be in a state of grace (not in a state of mortal sin), and you must also meet the following conditions:

❖ Have the determination to avoid even the smallest sin and the desire to receive plenary forgiveness.

❖ Receive the Sacrament of Penance on the day of the ceremony or approximately within 20 days before or after.

❖ Receive Communion.

❖ Pray for the Pope's intentions. Although believers are free to choose, it is recommended that they pray the "Our Father" once and the "Hail Mary" once.

❖ In order to obtain plenary indulgence on another day during the same period, it is sufficient to receive the Sacrament of Penance only once, but Communion and prayer for the intentions of the Pope must be fulfilled on each occasion.
